NATIONAL PROJECT

"BUCKETS OF SUNSHINE"

In June 1996, our organization established a national project called "Buckets of Sunshine." The goal of the project is two-fold: 1) to provide "buckets" filled with personal care products to local crisis centers (particularly focused towards women and children); 2) to allow every chapter in the organization to work towards a common goal while creating media attention for our organization.

The first Buckets of Sunshine was presented at our year-end convention in 1999 in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. Since then, the state hosting our year-end convention submits an agency to be our recipient with the USWT Marketing Committee making the decision.
