List ways that the activity met the Shout Out with Pride requirements. Must complete 2 of 4 options listed on form and submit, include a link and photo of event for recognition:
[] Held a public membership event; include date, event and photo with chapter participation - showing how the chapter coordinated together. Example chapter shirts or merchandise.
[] Submitted newspaper/radio/other media outlet opportunities the chapter experienced within the current trimester. Example includes Facebook or TikTok live streaming. Include the link where the opportunity can be reviewed.
[] Have the Mayor or Governor sign your community's Proclamation (normally signed during Founder's Day or Women of Today Week but your chapter can choose when to celebrate your Proclamation).
[] Used the USWT Public Relations poster in your community—provide a snapshot of location where it is posted. Public announcements on social media; chapter members being recognized bywearing chapter clothing etc.

## Shout Out with Pride form can be submitted each trimester for recognition with:

1<sup>st</sup> submission being a small certificate,

2<sup>nd</sup> submission being a large certificate,

3<sup>rd</sup> submission being a "Shout Out" in the Today's Leader and/or social media (i.e. Facebook or other USWT social media)

Year-End recognition: If form is submitted all three trimesters, the chapter will receive a "**Shout Out**" at year-end in the Today's Leader AND on social media with photo of the chapter and accomplishments.
