Description of Project We put a flyer together that we posted on Facebook and shared extensively. The flyer offers the opportunity for families to purchase filled plastic eggs that our chapter will then hide the night before Easter. We offered 20 eggs for \$10, 40 eggs for \$20, and 60 eggs for \$30. We received ten orders for a total of \$210. We had expenses of \$15.92 for eggs, candy, and stickers so we had a profit of \$194.08. Four members spent 2.5 hours filling the eggs for a total of ten hours. Four members spent an hour going to the homes and hiding the eggs so we had a total of 14 hours invested in this project.
